## Central Emergency Response Fund High-Level Pledging Event 2020

### Pledge summary

On 8 December 2020, the following donors announced pledges totalling more than US\$370 million for 2021 – higher than those made at the pledging event a year ago for 2020. Four donors have pledged to the Fund for the first time, increasing CERF's donor base to 133 UN Member States and Observers since it was established in 2006. With additional 2020 funding also announced at the event, overall funding for this year has reached \$620 million, which is the second highest amount after 2019's record contribution of \$831.4 million in cash.
