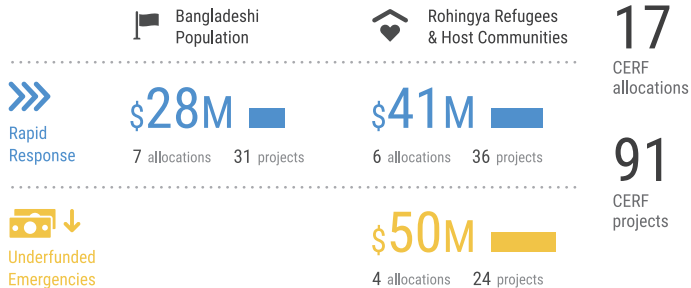


Since 2017, with the onset of the Rohingya Refugee crisis, along with the acceleration of climate-change driven emergencies, CERF has provided nearly 120M dollars for the refugee response, as well as foods and cyclones reaching millions of the most vulnerable people in the country. Bangladesh was also one of the first countries of the world to do anticipatory action for floods at scale through CERF and is now expanding to cyclones and other hazards.

CERF ANTICIPATORY ACTION BANGLADESH

CERF Anticipatory Action provides pre-agreed financing in response to an imminent disaster. A flood trigger based on river flow and precipitation, gives a 15 day readiness trigger for Agencies to prepare, and then a 5 day activation trigger which releases the CERF funding. The activities include multi-purpose cash, WASH, animal feed and water proof storage, sexual and reproductive health, GBV and other support.

In 2020, the first year of the project, when floods submerged approximately one million households the AA program reached than 220,000 people received support before peak floods at a total cost of \$2.8 million from CERF.

Up to a million people receive early warning. The new cyclone AA project will follow a similar process but with a much shorter lead time - 5 days for readiness and less than 72 hours for action.

The current multi-year commitment from CERF is 7.5m to cover both riverine floods and cyclones, with the goal to expand to flash floods and other hazards in the future.

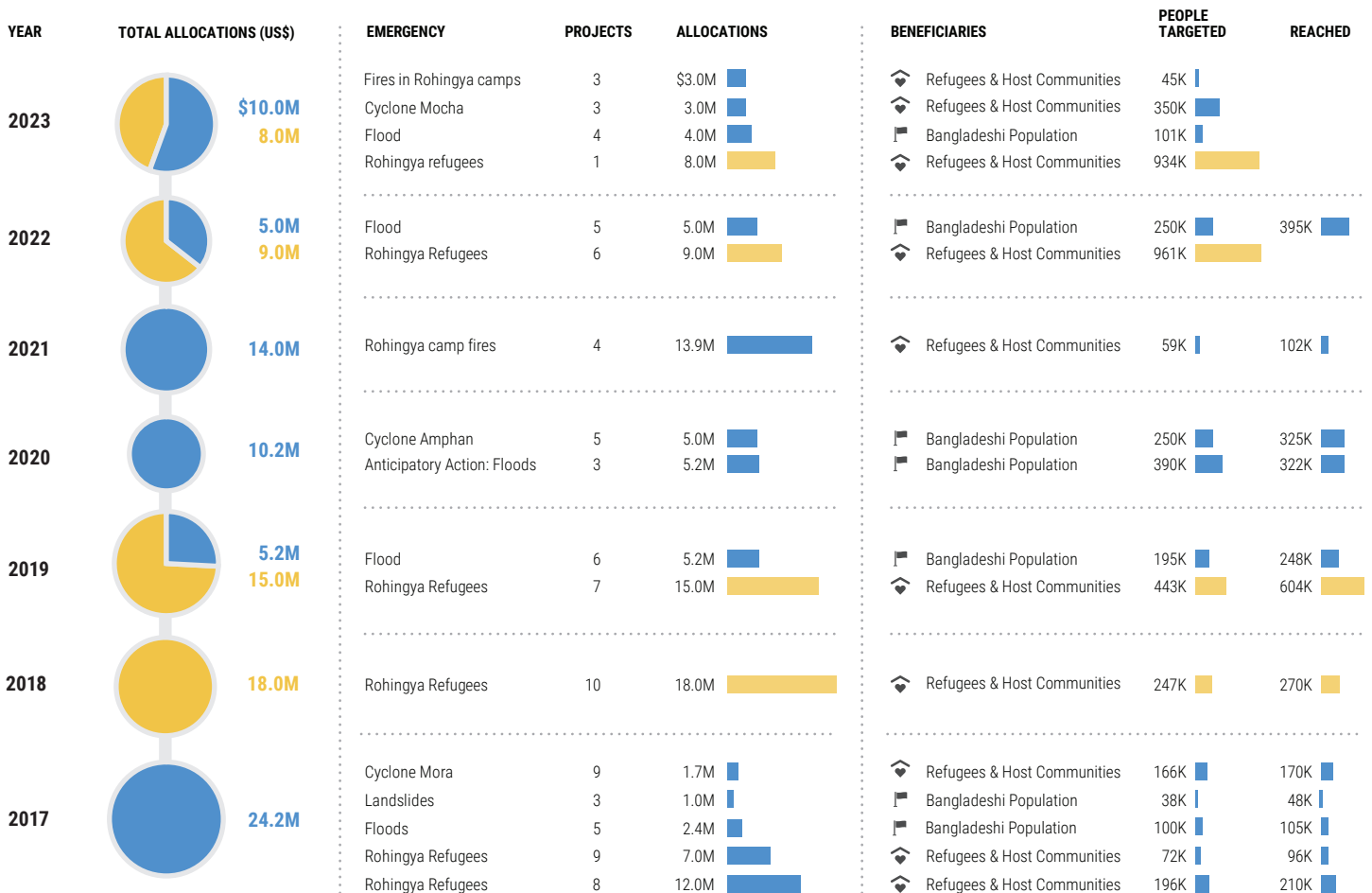
