

CERF FUNDING TO INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT AND REFUGEE CRISES (2011-2015)

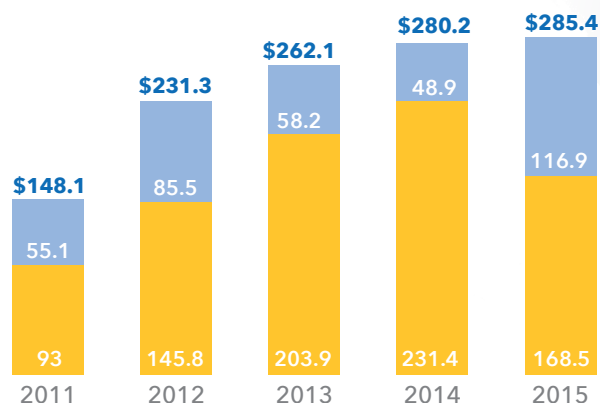
Since 2011, the Emergency Relief Coordinator has allocated over US\$1.2 billion from the Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF) to support life-saving humanitarian activities to assist millions of people forced from their homes by violence and instability. More than \$842 million has been allocated for response to internal displacement and refugee-related crises through CERF's Rapid Response Window, while almost \$365 million has been allocated through the Underfunded Emergencies Window.

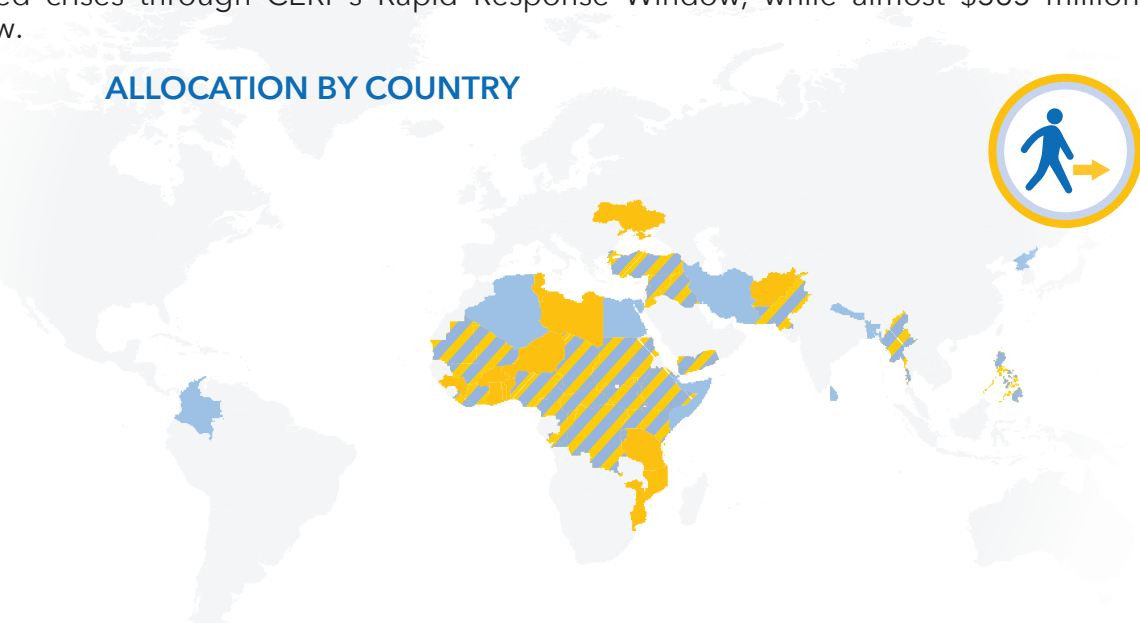

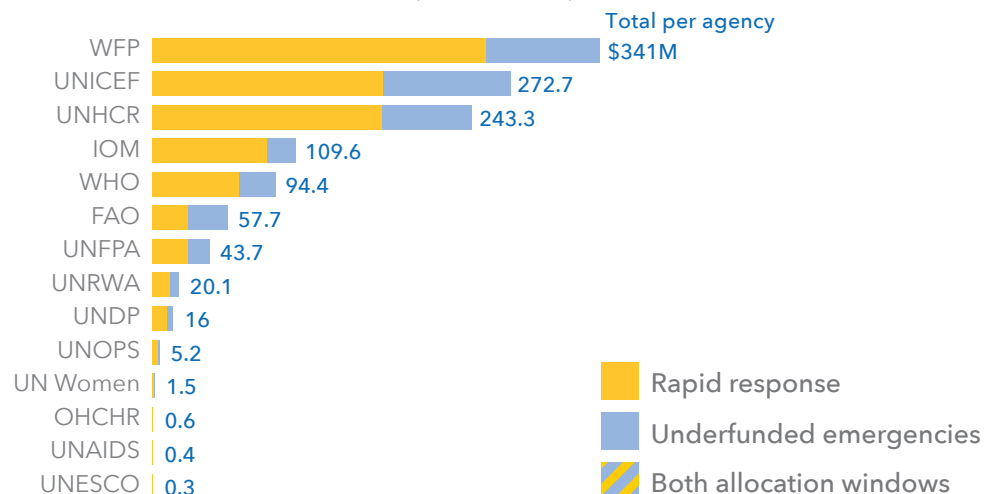
ALLOCATION BY YEAR (in US\$ million)
